RESET4Youth

RESET4Youth holistically supports young people experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness move into long term housing.

We provide early intervention to help young people at risk of homelessness secure suitable long-term accommodation and wraparound case management to retain housing and thrive.

We aim to:

- Enable young people to transition to long term housing
- Support young people to develop living skills
- Support young people to access education and training
- Enable young people to sustain their housing
- Support young people to access housing rental subsidies through Rent Choice Youth and practical assistance through brokerage

Who we help

We help young people in South West Sydney between the ages of 18-25 who are currently in emergency or transitional accommodation, couch surfing or rough sleeping.

Referral pathway

You can access the service through:

- Homelessness services such as youth refuges or transitional accommodation
- Outreach activities
- Health services and facilities
- Community events that engage young people
- Schools
- Community hubs
- Other social services such as family support, domestic and family violence
