What is the AMEP?

The Adult Migrant English program (AMEP) can help you to learn English.

The AMEP provides up to 510 hours of English lessons and childcare to newly arrived eligible migrants and humanitarian entrants.



What will I learn?

You will learn foundation English language and settlement skills to help you participate in Australian society. You will learn about Australian society, culture, customs and working in Australia.

You will learn speaking, listening, reading and writing skills to help you with everyday living, work and further study.

How can I study?

- Classes: full-time or part-time; during the day, evening or on Saturday
- Volunteer Tutor Program: one-on-one with a tutor in a library or other location at a time convenient to you
- Distance Learning: flexible learning with an AMEP teacher at a time that suits you. You can study online or over the phone. You can use books and CDs to help you learn English.

Attendance is very important in the AMEP. If you need to be absent, you need to tell AMEP staff so that you don't lose any of your AMEP hours. If you attend regularly you may be eligible for additional hours.

- AMEP Extend you can apply for up to 490 hours to improve your English if you have a good attendance record and make good progress in your studies.
- PEP you can apply for up to 200 hours to study a course that prepares you for work.

Is childcare available?

We can arrange childcare while you attend classes. Free childcare is available for children under school age.

How do I know if I'm eligible?

Phone us or visit a TAFE campus near you to find out if you are eligible for the AMEP. Your visa and passport details will tell us if you are eligible.

How do I enrol?

To enrol you will need to attend an interview at one of our locations so we can assess your English level and arrange a suitable learning plan for you.

You must register for the AMEP within six (6) months of your visa commencement date or arrival in Australia.
