Program Overview

Unique 6-month coaching program - to support aged care providers in delivering more specialised care to LGBTI older people.

The coaching program is a **leadership development opportunity** for senior leaders in aged care services to work closely with a highly experienced advisor over a 6-month period to build their own knowledge and expertise to impact inclusive practice in their workplace in the provision of care for LGBTI older people.

This program is structured around MyAgedCare Specialisation Verification (SVF). SVF is an initiative of the Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care. **Sessions will be tailored to the participants and their organisations.**
